




Recording Reseed Events


When you have a paddock that you are going to reseed, there are two things you need to do on PBI. Firstly, in the cover immediately before the reseed, (after the last grazing has taken place) set the paddock status to **Reseed**. Leave it at reseed until the new grass has grown. When you want to bring this paddock back into the rotation, you then record a cover for this paddock and change the status back to **Grass**. The paddock will then be back on the Grass Wedge again.

The second point is optional. This is the area in PBI where you can record what particular type of seed was used to reseed a paddock, the date it was reseeded, the amount and method used.


To do this, you click into the **Reseed Event**.



Select ADD NEW RESEED:




Then tick the small box to the right of the paddock name to select it, or click on *Check All* if you want to select all paddocks








Then click into the box Reseed Date and select date from Calendar.




Select Reseed Method



You can choose whether to enter the amounts in kg/ha or kg/acre




Underneath this you then select the type of seed. In the **Variety Type** box, you then select one from the list of numerous varieties from the drop-down list underneath **Variety**. Then in the final box, enter the amount.







There is an option to add up to 5 varieties of seed but if you want to add more, you simply click on **Add Another Variety**



Printing to Excel or PDF

At the top of the screen, there is an option to print out the list of reseed events, either into an excel or pdf file.
